Each artist may submit up to 3 original works for consideration. The jury



committee reserves the right to refuse work that is not in keeping with the spirit of the exhibit. We encourage participation from a diverse audience and subject matter.

All works must be labeled with the artist's name, title, date, mediums used, price - if available for sale, and indicate top and bottom of work. The art piece(s) MUST BE READY TO HANG, this means appropriate hanging fixtures MUST be in place! Please include a current Artist History/Bio. Please note that if you wish to remain anonymous we will honour this request.
